

Stainless Steel Travel Tumbler with Flip Lid

SUBLIMATION (Mug Press)

Printing	When using SubliJet refer to the Sawgrass Print Manager Manual or if using Epson or another brand of ink use the instruction manual provided from the vendor you purchased your ink from. All images should be MIRRORED unless specified below.
Important	When the image is printed, it may look dull on the paper—this is normal. Trim the image to make it easier to position on your item. Secure your image to the object with heat tape to keep it from slipping or shifting.When pressing is done, Open the press slowly and gently remove the object and remove the paper (be careful not to let the paper shift across the surface of the object, or you may create a "ghost" image).
Mug Press Setup	 Before pressing, test the pressure using a blank travel tumbler. The pressure should be medium. Adjust pressure accordingly. Ensure that your mug press has reached the idle or press temperature before using. Make sure you are using the Travel tumbler Element. Do not use excessive pressure. Doing so will damage your mug press and damage your travel tumbler.
Pressing	 OVERVIEW Press Temperature: 355°F (180°C) for 80 seconds Medium Pressure, Hot peel 1. Remove lid and straw. Make sure you are using the 11oz/ 15oz Mug Element. 2. Tape imaged sublimation paper onto your travel tumbler. Place image facing the travel tumbler. 3. Set the mug press at 355°F for 80 seconds. If your press has an idle and press temperature setting, adjust the time accordingly. 4. Ensure mug press has reached temperature. Place the travel tumbler into your mug press. Close Mug Press. 5. Once pressing is done, open mug press, and take travel tumbler out of press. Use gloves or heat resistant cloth to handle the hot travel tumbler. 6. Peel sublimation paper off. 7. Leave on table to cool. Do not dunk in water. Caution: Travel tumbler is extremely hot when in the mug press, do not handle with bare hands Note: Temperature and time settings are only a guide/starting point, some mug presses may require some fine tweaking of the temperature and time.

SUBLIMATION (Convection Oven)

Important When the image is printed, it may look dull on the paper—this is normal. Trim the image make it easier to position on your item. Convection SetupMake sure that the shelves are properly set up. You will need a shrink sleeve/ film.Recommend shrink film/sleeve: W 5.9" x H 7.67" (P-SUB-SF-150195).	
Tips: You can use a weeder to help you remove the shrink. You can cut the shrink sle length to fit better. Removing the sleeve while still hot will minimize sticking to the pro- and make removal easier.	auct

 Remove the lid and straw. Design your image and print it out on sublimation paper sublimation ink printer. 	r with
2. Tape imaged sublimation paper onto travel tumbler.	
3. Place and center the product inside the shrink film/sleeve.	
 Use heat gun on low setting to shrink the wrap to the contour of the product. Beg with the side away from the transfer first. Ensure the wrap only encases the sides the product leaving top and bottom open. 	
5. Repeat above steps for each item to include in production run.	
6. Set the convection oven at 360°F for 4 minutes .	
 Ensure convection oven has reached temperature, place the travel tumblers in the preheated oven. 	
8. Close Convection oven.	
 Once curing is done, open convection oven, and take the travel tumbler out of the oven. Use gloves or heat resistant cloth to handle the hot travel tumbler. 	
10. Peel sublimation paper and shrink film off and leave it to cool off completely.	
Caution: Travel tumbler is extremely hot when in the mug press, do not handle with bahands	æ
